ORDINANCE NO. AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P15,000.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN MATERIALS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF PAVEHENT MARKINGS AND TRAFFIC SIGHS FOR THE MANTLA POLICE DEPARTMENT. Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that: SECTION 1. The amount of P15,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the expected additional income from approved revenue-raising measures to be made available for the acquisition of the following materials for the maintenance of pavement markings and traffic signs for the Manila Police Department: 200 gallons - Reflectorized Traffic paint, yellow 200 gallons - Reflectorized Traffic paint, white 20 gallons - Traffic paint thinner 15 gallons - Traffic paint vehicle The above composite paint shall follow the requirements and specifications of MIL-P-17234 or the Government Standard Specification No. 13-42, said to be duly tested and approved by the National Institute of Technology. 300 pieces - 12" x 18" signboard - 18" x 24" 100 " - 12" x 30" 100 " - 24" x 24" 20 gallons - enamel white paint 20 quarts -- mandarin red enamel paint 20 quarts -- black enamel paint The above steel signboards shall be of: 1. Flat steel sheet gauge #16 2. The corners shall be rounded. 3. They shall be properly cleaned of oily materials and rust before coating. 4. They shall be printed first with one coat of primer lead 5. As finished products they shall have two additional coatings of paint on the surface either of yellow or white according to the type of signs to be painted. 80 pieces - 3" x 3" x 10° yakall 300 pieces - in x 2" lag screws (galvanized) SEC. 2.
