AN ORDINANCE RENAMING OREGON STREET IN PACO "GALICANO APACIBLE STREET."

WHEREAS, Galicano Apacible, who was born in June, 1864, in Balayan, Batangas, was one of the more renowned and esteemed patriots of the Philippine Revolution;

WHEREAS, his life is a brilliant record of intellectual achievements - in time of war, as a gifted and conscientious propagandist and in time of peace, as a selfless and patriotic political leader;

WHEREAS, it has become the policy of the City of Manila to name public streets after our heroes;

WHEREAS, naming Oregon Street after him will not only be in keeping with said policy but also will be a fitting tribute to his memory: Now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Oregon Street in Paco is hereby renamed "Galicano Apacible Street."

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Originally enacted by the Municipal Board on February 2, 1968; vetoed by His Honor, the Mayor, on February 23, 1968; and repassed with modifications by said Body at its regular session today, June 21, 1968.


