

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS FROM FINANCIAL LIABILITY DUE TO LOSS OF TEXTBOOKS LOANED TO STUDENTS IN THE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, teachers in the city public schools are held responsible for the textbooks loaned to the pupils or students and are required, at the end of the school year, to pay for the cost of lost and unreturned textbooks; and

WHEREAS, the practice of school authorities of deducting the cost of lost and unreturned textbooks from the salaries of said teachers makes the latter, literally, guarantors or sureties of the students for the textbooks loaned to the latter although they have no control over the actuations of the individual pupil or student concerned: Now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Public school teachers are hereby exempted from financial liability due to loss of textbooks loaned to students in the city public schools.

SEC. 2 . This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
