

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P1,295,000.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO COMPLETE THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE OBRERO MARKET, INCLUDING THE PUTTING UP OF STALLS, A BOOSTER PUMP AND SUCTION PUMP, TWO ADDITIONAL ESCALATORS, TWO GARBAGE GRINDERS AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS ESSENTIAL AND/OR UNAVOIDABLE CHARGES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The amount of P1,295,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available to complete the construction of the Obrero Market, including the putting up of stalls, a booster pump and suction pump, two additional escalators, two garbage grinders and other miscellaneous essential and/or unavoidable charges.

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
