

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING WASHINGTON STREET IN SAMPALOC, FROM MATIMYAS STREET TO THE DIMASALANG ROTONDA, "ANTONIO M. MACEDA STREET."

WHEREAS, the late Dean Antonio M. Maceda served the government in various capacities for a period of thirty-nine years, starting his career as a high school teacher and retiring from the service as the Superintendent of the Division of City Schools of Manila;

WHEREAS, as an active civic leader, the late Antonio M. Maceda was one of the founders of the Philippine Public School Teachers Association, the organizer of several Parent-Teacher Associations, a member of the Boards of Governors of the Philippine National Red Cross and the Philippine Boy Scouts;

WHEREAS, even after his retirement from the government service he continued to dedicate his efforts to the education of the youth, having held the position of Dean of the College of Education of the Araneta University in 1958, professor at the National University from 1961 to 1969, and President of the Philippine Normal School for two years;

WHEREAS, it is only proper and fitting that the memory of the late Antonio M. Maceda be honored and perpetuated as a grateful gesture of the people he served faithfully and well: Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:


SECTION 1. Washington Street in Sampaloc, from Matimyas Street to the Dimasalang Rotonda is hereby renamed "Antonio M. Maceda Street."


SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila at its regular session today, March 5, 1971.




