

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALARY ADJUSTMENT OF NINETEEN (19) HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS AND FORTY-ONE (41) ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHERS WHO WERE DESIGNATED AND ARE ACTUALLY PERFORMING THE DUTIES OF TEACHER COMMUNITY COORDINATORS, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The salary adjustment of nineteen (19) high school teachers and forty-one (41) elementary school teachers who were designated and are actually performing the duties of Teacher Community Coordinators, from their present salary schedules under Ordinance No. 7046 to P6,240.00 per annum each, is hereby authorized.

SEC. 2. The amount of P75,200.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated to be made available for the salary adjustment authorized in Section One hereof, subject to the following conditions:

(a) No teacher shall be appointed and/or designated to the position of Teacher Community Coordinator unless he or she possesses the qualification standard promulgated by the Bureau of Public Schools; and

(b) The incentive pay provided for under Section 4 of Ordinance No. 7046 shall not apply to the sixty (60) Teacher Community Coordinators who will be appointed and/or designated as such in implementation of this ordinance.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
