

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE PAYMENT OF GARBAGE FEES ON FIXED SCHEDULES FOR BUSINESS, TRADE, OCCUPATIONAL AND OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS; SETTING RULES AND REGULATIONS THEREFOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Schedule of Fees. - All business, trade, occupational and other establishments shall pay a quarterly garbage fee in accordance with the following schedule:

A. Business, trade, occupational and other establishments:

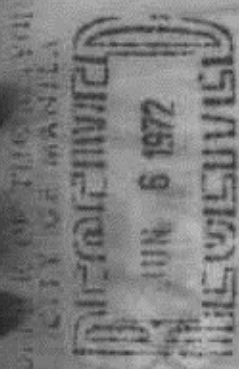

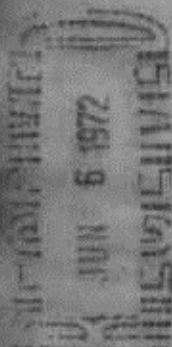

PROVIDED, That when only part of the building appertains to a business establishment only that part shall constitute a commercial establishment.

SEC. 2. Application, Contents of. - A written application on the form prescribed for the purpose shall be made by the owners, agents, managers or administrators mentioned in Section 1 hereof to the City Treasurer. Said application shall set forth the name and location of the business, trade or occupation the applicant is engaged in.

SEC. 3. Payment of Fees. - The fees prescribed in Section 1 hereof shall be paid in advance within the first 25 days of each quarter; PROVIDED, That were the fee is paid in quarterly receipts, the fee for the business, trade, occupational or other establishments opening for the first time shall be \$16.00; PROVIDED, FURTHER, That no Mayor's permit shall be issued for the business, trade, occupational or other establishments covered by this Ordinance unless the garbage fee herein prescribed is paid and up-to-date.

SEC. 4. Any failure to pay the above fees within the period prescribed in Section 3 hereof shall be subjected to a surcharge of 3% for every quarter or fraction of delinquency and that no Mayor's permit may be renewed unless the garbage fee herein prescribed is paid in full and up-to-date.

SEC. 5. Use of Fees Collected. - As a matter of policy, all fees collected under this Ordinance are to be exclusively appropriated by the Municipal Board for the improvement of garbage collection and disposal service in the City of Manila including the acquisition of garbage trucks, equipment, supplies and materials.

SEC. 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

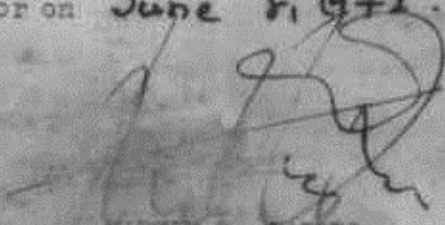
SEC. 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Originally enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila on May 16, 1972 and modified at its regular session today, May 25, 1972.

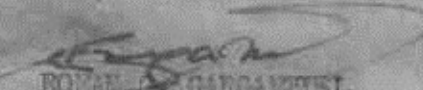

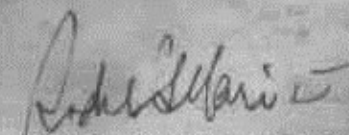
