

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE OF THE
COMPILATION OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA,
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section four hundred sixty-nine of the
Compilation of the Ordinances of the City of Manila, is hereby
amended to read as follows:

*SEC. 469. Projector rooms, storage
rooms, and dressing rooms. - All projector rooms,
storage rooms, and dressing rooms within build-
ings used for theatrical and/or cinematograph
purposes shall be wholly and completely con-
structed of fireproof heat-resisting material.
It shall be unlawful to use any projector room,
storage room, or dressing room or permit or
cause such projector room, storage room, or
dressing room to be used if such room is not
constructed wholly and completely of fire-
proof heat-resisting material. It shall like-
wise be unlawful to lock, bolt, or barricade
the door leading to the projector room during
screening hours or to construct or maintain
obstacles therein for the purpose of hindering
or preventing immediate access thereto by
officers of the law."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
