

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ANY PERSON WHO SHALL WITNESS A FLAG CEREMONY BEING CONDUCTED TO STAND AT ATTENTION; PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Any person who shall witness a flag ceremony being conducted, is hereby required to stand at attention, without prejudice to the free exercise of religious worship.

SEC. 2. No badly faded or tattered flag except those used in the battlefield shall be used in a flag ceremony.

SEC. 3. Persons violating the provisions of Section 1 hereof shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not exceeding P200.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
