ORDINANCE NO. 4 AN OFDINANCE FENAMING RADN STREET IN THE SECOND DISTRICT, FROM ONOPIN STREET TO BILIBID VIEJO STREET, "GONZAIO" PUYAT STREET." One such unknown personality who undisputedly would belong to these early Filipinos who shaped the destiny of our country is the late Gonzalo Puyat, world-wide known philantropist and an industrial WHEREAS, starting from a lowly station in life, Gonzalo Puyat, with vivid imagination, vigor and fortitude, went headlong into several business undertakings, thereby championing Filipino labor and capital and by doing so rose to gain unparalleled success; WHEREAS, Conzalo Puyat has carved his rightful place in the hearts of his countrymen and in Philippine economics; and WHEREAS, if only to serve as a reminder to our people, especially rowadays when the Philippines is uncargoing a "denocratic revolution" to establish a "New Society" that any person, no metter how low his beginnings were, can attain the arms of success thru diligence, thrift, industry and patience: !bw, therefore, Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that: SECTION 1. Reon Street in the second district of Manila, from Ongpin Street to Hilibid Viejo Street, is hereby renumed "Conzalo Puyat Street," SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
