

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING RAON STREET IN THE SECOND DISTRICT,
FROM ONGPIN STREET TO BILIBID VIEJO STREET, "GONZALO
PUYAT STREET."

WHEREAS, our country is favored to have men who, although unknown, helped carve the destiny of the Philippines. One such unknown personality who undisputedly would belong to these early Filipinos who shaped the destiny of our country is the late Gonzalo Puyat, world-wide known philanthropist and an industrial giant;

WHEREAS, starting from a lowly station in life, Gonzalo Puyat, with vivid imagination, vigor and fortitude, went headlong into several business undertakings, thereby championing Filipino labor and capital and by doing so rose to gain unparalleled success;

WHEREAS, Gonzalo Puyat has carved his rightful place in the hearts of his countrymen and in Philippine economic; and

WHEREAS, if only to serve as a reminder to our people, especially nowadays when the Philippines is undergoing a "democratic revolution" to establish a "New Society" that any person, no matter how low his beginnings were, can attain the acme of success thru diligence, thrift, industry and patience: Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Raon Street in the second district of Manila, from Ongpin Street to Bilibid Viejo Street, is hereby renamed "Gonzalo Puyat Street."

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
