AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN OFFICIAL COAT OF ARMS FOR THE CITY OF MANILA, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PHILIPPINE HERALDRY COMMITTEE AND APPROVED BY HIS EXCELLENCY, THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. An official Coat of Arms for the City of Manila, as recommended by the Philippine Heraldry Committee and approved by His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, is hereby adopted, the description, reproduction or facsimile of which are as follows:

"On a kalasag divided: on chief gules, superimposed a mother of pearl proper; on base azure, a sea lion engarde in or resting on argent and azure wavy and alternately."



SEC. 2. Ordinance No. 6492 is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. Any person who, in any manner, casts dishonor, ridicule or contempt upon the above-described official Coat of Arms of the City of Manila shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than P200.00 or by imprisonment of not more than six months, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
