AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING A PENALTY OF TWENTY PESOS (P20.00) FINE, EXCLUSIVE OF COURT COSTS, AND IMPRISONMENT FOR TWO (2) DAYS ON PERSONS CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THE "JAY-WALKING" ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The penalty of twenty pesos (P20.00) fine, exclusive of court costs, and imprisonment for two (2) days shall be imposed on persons convicted of violating the "jay-walking" ordinances of the City of Manila.

SEC. 2. All ordinances in conflict with the provisions of Section One hereof are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
