

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE ESCO ANNEX OF MANUEL A. ROXAS HIGH SCHOOL "CARLOS P. GARCIA HIGH SCHOOL."

WHEREAS, the late Hon. Carlos P. Garcia, had spent the best part of his life in the service of his country as School Teacher, Representative, Governor, Senator, Vice-President, President of the Philippines and finally, as President of the Constitutional Convention;

WHEREAS, during his incumbency as President of the Philippines, he effected numerous improvements in the government for the benefit and welfare of his country and people, and enunciated several policies to make his administration more responsive to the needs and clamor of the Filipino people;

WHEREAS, in his sincere desire to help in the framing of the New Constitution and to see to it that sacred rights and freedom of his people are fully guaranteed, he ran and won as Delegate to the Constitutional Convention and because of the proven, tested and unassuming quality of his leadership, he was overwhelmingly elected to the highest seat of the Constitutional Convention; Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The Esco Annex of Manuel A. Roxas High School is hereby named "Carlos P. Garcia High School."

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Originally enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila on August 2, 1973, vetoed by His Honor, the Mayor on August 21, 1973 and the veto overridden today, September 4, 1973.
