

ORDINANCE IMPOSING A PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN P20.00 FINE, EXCLUSIVE OF COURT COSTS, AND/OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN TWO (2) DAYS, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COURT, ON ALL PERSONS CONVICTED UNDER SECTION 1031 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1600, KNOWN AS THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA, PROHIBITING EXPECTORATION.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The penalty of not more than P20.00 fine, exclusive of court costs, and/or imprisonment for not more than two (2) days, at the discretion of the Court, shall be imposed on all persons convicted of violating Section 1031 of Ordinance No. 1600, known as the Revised Ordinances of the City of Manila, prohibiting expectoration.

SEC. 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of Section 1 hereof are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
