ORDINANCE NO. 7462

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P16,000.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SET OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL LIGHTS TO BE INSTALLED AT THE INTERSECTION OF ESCOLTA STREET AND PLAZA STA. CRUZ.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:


SECTION 1. The amount of P16,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available for the purchase of a set of traffic signal lights to be installed at the intersection of Escolta Street and Plaza Sta. Cruz.


SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila at its regular session today, January 30, 1974.




