AN ORDINANCE RENAMING SAMPALOC HEALTH CENTER IN THE THIRD DISTRICT OF MANILA "DR. DEMETRIO BELMONTE HEALTH CENTER".

WHEREAS, the late Dr. Demetrio Belmonte was Manila's first Assistant City Health Officer from 1940 to 1960 and later served as City Health Officer from 1960 up to the time of his retirement on December 1, 1961;

WHEREAS, Dr. Belmonte dedicated the best years of his life to the betterment of public health and had been the recipient of several awards and citations for outstanding achievements in this field of endeavor;

WHEREAS, in recognition of Dr. Belmonte's dedication to the public interest and his achievements in the field of public health which benefited the citizenry immeasurably, the Sampaloc Health Center, one of the early health centers he organized in Manila, is hereby renamed "Dr. Demetrio Belmonte Health Center." Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:


SECTION 1. Sampaloc Health Center in the Third District of Manila is hereby renamed "Dr. Demetrio Belmonte Health Center".




