WHEREAS, the Central Judo Club (CJC) is a non-stock, non-profit organization registered under the Philippine Judo Federation, Inc., the national governing body of Judo in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, through leadership, programs, and activities, in cooperation with its partners, the club promotes, supports and develops Kodokan Judo as a sport, martial art, self-defense, recreation, fitness and health activity, and as a way of life. The Club aims for the propagation of Judo in the grassroots level, immersing in marginalized areas with disadvantaged backgrounds to promote equality, inclusion, and participation, whilst increasing confidence, happiness and resilience;

WHEREAS, the Central Judo Club (CJC) was founded by Sensei Anghel Mira in 1963 at the Rizal Memorial Sports Complex in Malate, Manila. Through hard work, the Club represented the country in the 4th Asian Games in Jakarta, Indonesia in 1962 and placed 2nd during the 15th National Judo Team Championship in 1965, held in Zamboanga City. The last known tournament the CJC joined is the 18th National Team Championship in 1975;

WHEREAS, in 2019, CJC was re-established through the initiative of the following personalities, namely: Gilbert Ramirez - President/Head Coach, Franco Teves – Vice-President, Karen Gaerlan - Secretary General, Helen Dawa – Treasurer and Ryan Kristopher Alcantara and Carl Dave Aseneta – Assistant Coaches;


