RESOLUTION TO RE-ESTABLISH THE SISTERHOOD AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MANILA AND CITY OF FUZHOU, CHINA PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. 74, SERIES OF 2017

WHEREAS, the City of Manila and City of Fuzhou, China signed a Sisterhood Agreement in 2017, under Resolution No. 74, Series of 2017, as a gesture of goodwill and cooperation between the two cities;

WHEREAS, the Sisterhood Agreement aimed to foster cultural, educational, and economic exchanges between the City of Manila and City of Fuzhou, China;

WHEREAS, the Sisterhood Agreement has been instrumental in establishing a strong relationship between the two cities, resulting in fruitful collaborations and exchanges;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has caused significant disruptions to the world, including the suspension of various exchanges and programs between the City of Manila and City of Fuzhou, China;

WHEREAS, the City of Manila and City of Fuzhou, China now recognize the importance of revitalizing the Sisterhood Agreement, which can serve as a crucial platform for re-establishing and strengthening their relationship: NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of Manila to re-establish, as it hereby re-establishes the Sisterhood Agreement between the City of Manila and City of Fuzhou, China pursuant to Resolution No. 74, Series of 2017; and be it FURTHER
