

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NO. 3258, AUTHORIZING THE REGULAR ASSIGNMENT OF STALLS IN THE CITY PUBLIC MARKETS TO THEIR ACTUAL OCCUPANTS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 3527.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3258, as amended by Ordinance No. 3527, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 1. All persons who on the date of the approval of this ordinance have been in continuous occupancy of any stall or stalls contested or otherwise, in any public market of the City for not less than six (6) months and whose occupancy thereof was not obtained thru force, fraud or misrepresentation, shall be entitled to regular assignment thereto, the provisions of the Market Code to the contrary notwithstanding: PROVIDED, That such persons shall file with the Office of the City Treasurer within sixty (60) days after the publication of a notice to this effect, in at least two newspapers of general circulation in the City, and the posting of said notice in bulletin boards and other conspicuous places of city markets, a formal application for regular assignment of their occupied stalls: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That an additional period of sixty (60) days is hereby granted, to be counted from the last day of another publication, within which such applications under the conditions above mentioned may be filed: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the applicants are not in any way disqualified to acquire stalls in the City public markets under the provisions of Ordinance No. 2898, otherwise known as the Market Code: AND PROVIDED FINALLY, That in order to properly determine the right-party or parties who may avail of the provisions of this Ordinance, the City Treasurer, shall, within fifteen (15) days from and after the date of approval hereof, submit a certified complete and up-to-date list of all temporary stallholders in all the public markets of the City, said list to contain the following informations:

1. Name of temporary stallholder
2. Civil Status
3. Stalls (numbers)
4. Under what authority stalls came to be occupied, citing pertinent documents if any
5. Date of special assignment
6. Date stalls were occupied
7. Name of original holder or occupants."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
