

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION TWO OF ORDINANCE NO. 3360, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 3402, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES ON NON-ISSUANCE OF SALES INVOICES OR RECEIPTS BY BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS SUBJECT TO MUNICIPAL LICENSE FEES BASED ON GROSS SALES OR RECEIPTS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3360, as amended by Ordinance No. 3402, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred pesos or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court: PROVIDED, NEVERTHELESS, That any violation hereof may, with the approval of the Mayor, be compromised by the City Treasurer for not less than one hundred (P100.00) pesos: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the compromise fees shall be paid only in the office of the City Treasurer in the City Hall and only on receipt provided therefor: AND PROVIDED, FINALLY, That no employee, personnel or representative of the City Treasurer shall be authorized to collect or receive said compromise fees outside of his office in the City Hall."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
