

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 94 OF ORDINANCE No. 2411, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE PLUMBING CODE, SO AS TO PERMIT THE ADOPTION OF SPECIAL REMEDY IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 94 of Ordinance No. 2411, otherwise known as the Plumbing Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 94. CONNECTION WITH SANITARY SEWER. - The connection with the sanitary sewer shall not be made without permission, and shall be made in such manner that any and all of the service water, as well as house, stable, and other liquid wastes, will flow to the sanitary sewer: PROVIDED, THAT isolated hydrants, used exclusively for garden purposes, and water separately metered, and not intended for the sewer, in the discretion of the proper authorities, need not flow to the sanitary sewer: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That in cases where it is impractical or difficult to make the connection herein required, a special remedy may be adopted or permitted by the City Public Service Officer if in his discretion such special remedy will be equally sanitary."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
