

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE CARABAO MEAT IN THE CITY OF MANILA, AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell or offer for sale carabao meat in the City of Manila.

SEC. 2. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than P200.00, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court. If the violation is committed by a firm or corporation, the manager or managing director or the person in charge with the management thereof, shall be criminally responsible therefor.

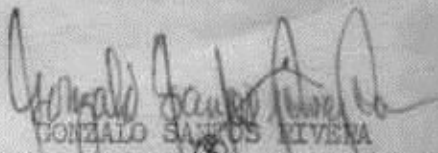
SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and shall be enforceable up to January 31, 1955.
