

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING SPECIAL POLICEMEN AND WATCHMEN IN THE CITY OF MANILA TO WEAR COMPLETE UNIFORM, INSIGNIAS, AND BADGES AND HAVE IN THEIR POSSESSION THEIR IDENTIFICATION CARDS WHILE ON DUTY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

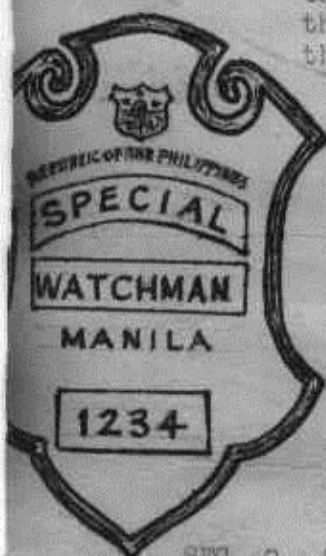
Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. All special policemen and watchmen in the City of Manila while on duty should have in their possession their respective identification cards duly approved by the Chief of Police or his duly authorized representative and should wear complete uniform as follows:

- (a) Long khaki pants and khaki shirt with long sleeves;
- (b) Tan leather shoes (either low or high cut);
- (c) Khaki Pershing cap;
- (d) Arm band three inches wide and of convenient length and blue background bearing the following designs:

The words SPECIAL POLICE or SPECIAL WATCHMAN must be placed above the name of the agency, institution or establishment concerned; the letterings must be in white, vertical, and in commercial gothic; the height of the letters of SPECIAL POLICE or SPECIAL WATCHMAN must be one and one-half (1-1/2) inches and those of the name of the agency, establishment or institution, one-half (1/2) inch, with clearance between them; the distance between SPECIAL POLICE or SPECIAL WATCHMAN and the name of the agency, establishment or institution must be one fourth (1/4) of an inch; and the upper and lower edges from the letters must also be one fourth (1/4) of an inch; and

- (e) Badge and insignia in silver color of the respective size and shape appearing below with the same inscriptions as indicated thereon, differing only in the name SPECIAL POLICE or SPECIAL WATCHMAN, as the case may be:



Helmet Insignia



Collar Insignia

SEC. 2. The use of patches by special police or special watchmen is hereby prohibited.

SEC. 3. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred pesos or by imprisonment of not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

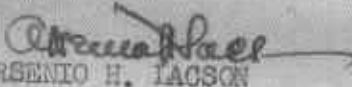

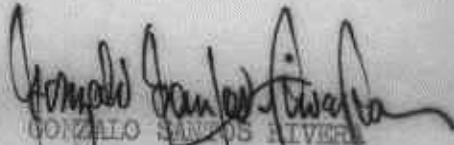
SEC. 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

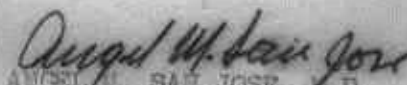
