

AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING FROM PUBLIC USE THE DEAD END PORTION OF ALHAMBRA STREET ON ARQUIZA STREET, ERMITA, CONTAINING AN AREA OF 72.5 SQUARE METERS, DECLARING THE SAME AS PATRIMONIAL PROPERTY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF MANILA, AND AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF THE SAID CITY PROPERTY TO THE FOREIGN OPERATIONS ADMINISTRATION (FOA) AT A RENTAL OF P1.00 PER YEAR.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The dead end portion of Alhambra Street on Arquiza Street, Ermita, containing an area of 72.5 square meters, is hereby withdrawn from public use.

SEC. 2. The above piece of land described in Section 1 hereof is hereby declared as patrimonial property of the government of the City of Manila.

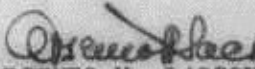
SEC. 3. The lease of the aforesaid city property, containing an area of 72.5 square meters, to the Foreign Operations Administration (FOA) at a rental of P1.00 per year is hereby authorized.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

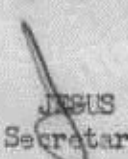
