

AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING FROM PUBLIC USE THAT PORTION OF PLAZA JACINTO ADJOINING THE CHILDREN'S LIBRARY ON THE SOUTH END, TONDO, AND EXEMPTING THE WOMEN'S WELFARE MOVEMENT (SWA), TONDO DISTRICT CHAPTER, FROM THE PAYMENT OF THE NECESSARY BUILDING PERMIT FEES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A ONE-STORY BUILDING FOR ITS USE AS SEWING CENTER AT THE ABOVE PLACE, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITION.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. That portion of Plaza Jacinto adjoining the Children's Library on the south end, Tondo, is hereby withdrawn from public use.

SEC. 2. The Women's Welfare Movement (SWA), Tondo District Chapter, is hereby exempted from the payment of the necessary building permit fees for the construction of a one-story building for its use as sewing center at the site mentioned in Section one hereof: PROVIDED, That the same shall be temporary in nature.

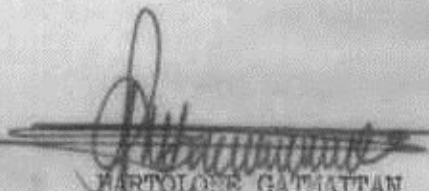
SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

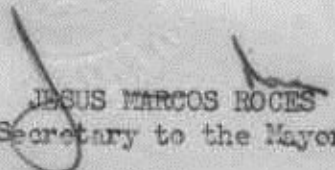

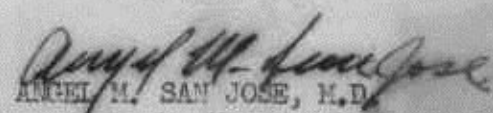
