

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 24 AND 645 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1600, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA, REFERRING TO THE REGISTRATION AND VACCINATION OF DOGS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Sections 24 and 645 of Ordinance No. 1600, otherwise known as the Revised Ordinances of the City of Manila, as amended by Ordinance No. 3513, are hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 24. Every dog three months of age or more shall be vaccinated every six (6) months by the City Veterinarian with anti-rabies (Pasteurs) vaccine free of charge at the City Pound: PROVIDED, That if vaccination is done by a licensed private veterinarian, a certificate from him to this effect shall be shown to the City Veterinarian every January following the date of vaccination: AND PROVIDED, FURTHER, That a fee of One Peso (P1.00) shall be charged from owners of impounded unvaccinated dogs. Any owner or person having control or possession of any dog, who shall not present the same to the proper authority for vaccination as herein provided and/or who shall not comply with the provisions of Section 645 of the Revised Ordinances as herein amended, shall be punished by a fine of not more than P200.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 645. Registration and Annual Fees. Every dog three (3) months of age or over shall be registered with the Office of the City Health Officer and a license shall be granted for keeping such dog. For every license granted for keeping of such dog, whether male or female there shall be paid the sum of Two Pesos (P2.00) per annum, the same to be paid upon registration."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
