

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 930 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1600, KNOWN AS THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA, AS LASTLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 3519, BY PROVIDING EXTENSION OF SPECIAL REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICE, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 930 of Ordinance No. 1600, known as the Revised Ordinances of the City of Manila, as lastly amended by Ordinance No. 3519, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 930. TIME TO PLACE RECEPTACLES ON SIDEWALK, QUANTITIES OF RUBBISH, REMOVAL, FEES.- It shall be the duty of the occupant of every building, premises or place of business to have receptacles for garbage or rubbish placed on the outer edge of the sidewalk each day, or at the edge of the street if there is no sidewalk, at such time, not earlier than eight o'clock post meridian, as may be directed by the Department of Public Services: PROVIDED, That, upon favorable recommendation of the City Public Service Officer, the Mayor may permit industrial, commercial, or business establishments to place their receptacles outside their places of business earlier than 8:00 o'clock p.m. but not before 4:00 o'clock post meridian, when such industrial, commercial or business establishment can satisfactorily show that their closing hours are before 8:00 p.m. and that their refuse consists of rubbish only which includes waste or used paper, paste-boards, woven materials, matting or metallic vessels, broken glasses or porcelain or the like, subject however, to the condition that the receptacles to be used must be without leakage with appropriate cover and must be designed by the City Public Service Officer and that when the receptacle is placed outside it shall be so placed on the sidewalk or outer edge of the street if there be no sidewalk in a manner that they will not in any way cause obstruction to pedestrians and to the free flow of traffic and that no putrefying, decaying, or odorous matter, shall be placed in the receptacles: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That, upon favorable recommendation of the City Public Service Officer, the Mayor may permit daily collection of refuse from within the compound or premises of any industrial, commercial, business, or other establishments, when it is inconvenient, due to the nature of the refuse, for lack of sidewalk, or the narrowness or the busy condition of street, for the establishments to place their refuse receptacles at the sidewalk or at the street edge, subject, however, to the condition that such special collection service shall be allowed only when applied for, that the party or parties concerned shall pay a monthly service fee of Five (P5.00) Pesos, and that the refuse shall be contained in appropriate receptacles: AND PROVIDED, FURTHER, That, whenever there are large or unusual quantities of rubbish or trade refuse to be removed from any private building, premises, or place, the occupant thereof shall notify the City Public Service Officer at least twenty-four hours before removal is necessary, to collect such rubbish or trade refuse in order that proper transportation may be furnished for same: PROVIDED, FINALLY, That whenever the quantity of such rubbish or trade refuse exceeds one dump truckload, the occupant or occupants of said building, premises, or place shall either

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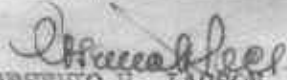
provide the necessary transportation to remove the same under the direction of the Department of Public Services, or cause the same to be removed by said Department. In the latter case, the party or parties concerned shall pay the Department of Public Services the sum of Ten Pesos for every truckload or less."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
