

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE MANILA LIONS CLUB FROM THE PAYMENT OF THE NECESSARY BUILDING PERMIT FEES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FIVE (5) WAITING SHEDS AT THE DIFFERENT SITES IN THE CITY OF MANILA, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The Manila Lions Club is hereby exempted from the payment of the necessary building permit fees for the construction of five (5) waiting sheds at the different sites in the City of Manila, as follows:

1. Plaza Lawton near Sunken Garden;
2. Reina Regente Street in front of the former Malaisic Police Station;
3. North Harbor in front of Pier 4;
4. Taft Avenue in front of the Apollonio High School; and
5. Taft Avenue near Apollonio High School Branch near the M. B. C. Building.

PROVIDED, That the construction of the above waiting sheds shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. That the exact location and some details shall be as indicated in figures 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 submitted for this purpose;
2. That no part of the structure shall be nearer than 0.60 meters from the nearside curb face (where available) of the street;
3. That no advertisement or inscription sign shall be attached or made part of the structure, except the name plate of the donor which should not be bigger than 1/4 square foot in area;
4. That the donor shall surrender all rights over the structure in favor of the National Government without compensation upon completion of the structure; and
5. That the government reserved the right to remove said structure if found unsafe or the space so occupied will be needed by the government for any public improvement.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
