

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1086 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1600, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA, AS LASTLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 3880, RELATIVE TO THE ADMISSION OF STUDENTS TO THE INTERMEDIATE AND HIGH SCHOOLS, BY DELETING SUB-SECTION (a) THEREFROM; PROVIDING ADDITIONAL EXEMPTIONS THEREIN; AND PRESCRIBING A SEPARATE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 1086 of Ordinance No. 1600, otherwise known as the Revised Ordinances of the City of Manila, as lastly amended by Ordinance No. 3880, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

*Sec. 1086. Admission to intermediate and high schools.- No pupils whose parents or guardians are not bona fide residents of the City of Manila shall hereafter be admitted to the City intermediate and high schools as defined in the course of study prescribed by the Director of Public Schools, except upon payment of an annual tuition fee of P160.00 in case of intermediate pupils; P170.00 in case of high school students; and P200.00 in case of students in the Rodriguez Vocational School, payable in four (4) equal installments, as follows:

1. Upon enrollment;
2. On or before August 5;
3. On or before November 5; and
4. On or before February 5.

PROVIDED, That pupils or students from any of the private schools of this City whose parents are bona fide residents of the City of Manila and who can show documentary evidence to that effect to the satisfaction of the authorities concerned, applying for admission into any of the public schools of the city shall be admitted free of charge: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That children of the members of the Cation Community (with the exception of those actually natives of Palawan) who are not bona fide residents of the province of Palawan shall be admitted, free of charge, to the city high schools; PROVIDED, FURTHER, That provincial students shall only be admitted into any city intermediate and high schools when all Manila students have been accommodated: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the fact of payment by any pupil of the tuition fees herein above provided shall not in any way be a bar to any legally constituted authority to suspend, expel, or punish said pupil for just cause and in case of such justified suspension or expulsion by any legally constituted authority of any pupil having paid such tuition fees, no claim for the refund of all or any portion thereof shall be considered: PROVIDED, FINALLY, That pupils in the intermediate grades and students in the high schools whose parents have moved their residences to the province shall be excluded from the public high schools and intermediate and elementary schools, with the exception of:

(a) Those pupils or students whose parents due to the nature of their employment are detailed for duty to the provinces shall not lose their right to be accommodated in the city public schools;

(b) Those pupils or students whose legal guardians are city residents;

(c) Those pupils or students whose parents, at the time of their enrollment, were bona fide city residents and are now residing in suburbs of Manila; and

(d) These pupils or students who are self-supporting and are actually working at the time of their application for enrollment and can present certificate signed by their employers.

SEC. 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance and/or shall make any false statement in the affidavit (D.C.S. Form No. 18) to be executed pursuant to the requirement hereof shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred pesos.

SEC. 3. All ordinances or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on June 1, 1959.
