

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ₱733,408.35 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF ADDITIONAL CLASSES IN THE HIGH SCHOOLS AND NEW CLASSES IN THE INTERMEDIATE GRADES FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 1959-1960.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The amount of ₱733,408.35 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds (from the surplus realized by the City as of June 30, 1959) existing in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated to be made available for the maintenance and operation of additional classes in the high schools and new intermediate classes for the school year 1959-1960, itemized as follows:
