

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE PORTION OF THE CITY-OWNED PROPERTY AT THE SOUTH CEMETERY FOR BURIAL PURPOSES; AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF THE SAME TO THE PUBLIC, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND PRESCRIBING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The vacant portion of the city owned lot in the South Cemetery, designated as Block 17-A, Graves 1 to 42; Block 18-A, Graves 1 to 48; Block 22-A, Graves 1 to 48; Block 23-A, Graves 1 to 48; Block 24-A, Graves 1 to 42, as surveyed and subdivided by the City Engineer's Office and indicated in the sketch submitted for the purpose, is hereby set aside for burial purposes.

SEC. 2. Subject to the regulations and existing ordinances governing the lease of burial lots in the South Cemetery, the lots described in the preceding section will be available for lease for 75 years subject to renewal at P30.00 per square meter to any bona fide resident of the City to be used solely for the purpose mentioned in Section 1 hereof: PROVIDED, That the rule "first come, first served" shall be observed in the granting of lease of the lots mentioned herein: PROVIDED FURTHER, That no single person can lease more than one (1) lot at a time and while the lot so leased by said person is still usable: AND PROVIDED FINALLY, That no lot mentioned in this ordinance shall be sub-leased to a third party.

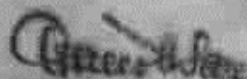
SEC. 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not exceeding two hundred (P200.00) pesos, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
