

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2898, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MARKET CODE OF THE CITY OF MANILA, RELATIVE TO MARKET SECTIONS.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 2898, otherwise known as the Market Code of the City of Manila, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 7. Market Sections. - Every public market shall be conveniently divided into sections according to the kinds of merchandise offered for sale, and the sale of merchandise pertaining to one section shall not be allowed in other sections. PROVIDED, That the section pertaining to cooked foods and refreshments shall be enclosed with a wire screen and provided with self-closing doors; PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the City Mayor for the good of the public may grant temporary permit not to exceed 60 days, to sell merchandise pertaining to one section in another section, except those sold in the cooked foods and refreshments section, until after said public good shall have been satisfied, but this power shall be exercised with utmost prudence."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
