

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4301, WHICH AUTHORIZES THE SALE, BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICES, OF COMPOST PRODUCTS PRODUCED IN THE COMPOSTING PLANT AT RODRIGUEZ DUMP, ISLA DE BALUT, TONDO, MANILA, AT FIXED PRICES, BY INSERTING A NEW SECTION IN SAID ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4301 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. The Department of Public Services of the City of Manila is hereby authorized to sell the compost products produced in the Composting Plant at Rodriguez Dump, Isla de Balut, Tondo, Manila, at the following prices:

- a. One (1) bag of 40 kilos (without container) 10.70
- b. One (1) metric ton 16.00

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That the above prices be subject to change by the City Public Service Officer, depending on the change or fluctuation of the cost of production: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That in no case shall the prices be higher or lower than the cost of production plus ten per cent (10%) overhead expenses: AND PROVIDED, FINALLY, That an increase or reduction of twenty-five per cent (25%) or more from the purchase price above shall be submitted to the Municipal Board for approval.

SEC. 2. The proceeds or income realized in the sale of compost fertilizers or products shall constitute as a revolving fund which shall be used to conduct studies and experiments for the further improvement of the compost product and for the purchase of materials and/or equipment for the Composting Plant: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That the following government entities, namely: Bureau of Agricultural Extension, Foreign Aid Organization, Philippine Sugar Institute, Philippine Virginia Tobacco Administration, PHILCOA, Bureau of Plant Industry, Bureau of Soil and the City Government, shall be given, free of charge, samples in such quantities as they may need for experimental purposes, of the fertilizers or compost products of the City's composting plant.

SEC. 3. Government schools of the City of Manila and their corresponding Parent-Teachers Association shall be given preference over all others in the purchase of the compost products."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
