

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE PORTION OF THE CITY-OWNED PROPERTY AT THE NORTH CEMETERY FOR BURIAL PURPOSES; AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF THE SAME TO THE PUBLIC, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The vacant portion of the city-owned land in the North Cemetery, designated as Section 286, Lots 14 & 15, as surveyed and subdivided by the City Engineer's Office, and shown on the accompanying sketch submitted for this purpose, is hereby set aside for burial purposes.

SEC. 2. Subject to regulations and existing ordinances governing the lease of burial lots in the North Cemetery, the lots described in the preceding section will be available for lease for 75 years subject to renewal at the rate of P30.00 per square meter to any bonafide resident of the City of Manila to be used solely for the purpose mentioned in Section one hereof; PROVIDED, That the rule "first come, first served", should be observed in granting the lease of the lots mentioned herein; PROVIDED, FURTHER, That no single person can lease more than one (1) lot at a time and while the lot so leased by said person is still usable; AND PROVIDED, FINALLY, That no lot mentioned in this ordinance shall be sub-leased to a third party.

SEC. 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not exceeding two hundred (P200.00) pesos, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
