

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 752-g OF CHAPTER 77, UNDER THE HEADING "SECOND-HAND DEALERS AND KEEPERS OF JUNK SHOPS", OF THE COMPILED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MANILA, BY EXEMPTING ARTICLES PURCHASED FROM UNITED STATES DEPOTS IN THE DAILY REPORT OF PURCHASES SUBMITTED TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Section 752-g of Chapter 77, under the heading "Second Hand Dealers and Keepers of Junk Shops", of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Manila, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 752-g. Duty of owners to submit daily report of articles purchased. Owners of second hand establishments are hereby required to submit a daily report to the Chief of Police of all articles purchased, and the names and addresses of the persons from whom the articles were purchased: PROVIDED, That articles purchased directly or indirectly from U. S. Government agencies, depots and imported from abroad duly released thru the Bureau of Customs of Manila shall be exempt from the requirement herein provided."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
