

AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING THE OPERATION OF SEC. 2(g), ORDINANCE NO. 4135 AS LASTLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 4188, RELATIVE TO THE CHARGING OF ADMISSION FEES FOR ENTRANCE INTO THE MANILA ZOOLOGICAL AND BOTANICAL GARDEN ON JULY 29, 1962 AND ON THE 29TH OF JULY OF EVERY YEAR, IN COMMEMORATION OF THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT AND INAUGURATION OF SAID MANILA ZOOLOGICAL AND BOTANICAL GARDEN.

WHEREAS, the Manila Zoological and Botanical Garden was re-established by the city government in order to afford the residents of Manila a place where they could spend their leisure. Since then, this project of the government has not only done a lot in giving pleasure to our constituents, but also provides a steady income for the City; and

WHEREAS, on that particular day, July 29 of every year, which is the inauguration date of the Manila Zoological and Botanical Garden, the city officials should take steps towards opening the gates of said Manila Zoological and Botanical Garden to the public free of charge; Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The operation of Sec. 2(g), Ordinance No. 4135, as lastly amended by Ordinance No. 4188 relative to the charging of admission fees for entrance into the Manila Zoological and Botanical Garden on July 29, 1962 and on the 29th of July of every year in commemoration of the re-establishment inauguration of said Manila Zoological and Botanical Garden is hereby suspended.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
