

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE PORTIONS OF THE CITY-OWNED PROPERTIES IN THE CITY CEMETERIES FOR BURIAL PURPOSES; AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF THE SAME TO THE PUBLIC, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The vacant portions of the city-owned lots in the North Cemetery, designated as Lots Nos. 11, 16, 17, 18, Section 151; Lot No. 1-4, Section 301 and in the South Cemetery designated as Blocks Nos. 19-A, 20-B and 21-B, as surveyed and subdivided by the City Engineer's Office, are hereby set aside for burial purposes.

SEC. 2. Subject to regulations and existing ordinances governing the lease of lots in the City Cemeteries, the lots described in the preceding section will be available for lease for 75 years subject to renewal at P30.00 per square meter to any bona fide resident of the City to be used solely for the purpose mentioned in Section one hereof; PROVIDED, That the rule of "first come, first served" should be observed in granting the lease of lots mentioned herein; PROVIDED, FURTHER, That no single person can lease more than one (1) lot at a time and while the lot so leased by said person is still usable; AND PROVIDED FINALLY, That no lot mentioned in this ordinance shall be sub-leased to a third party.


SEC. 3. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not exceeding two hundred (P200.00) pesos, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


