

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE BUILDING PRESENTLY HOUSING THE STA. ANA PUBLIC LIBRARY AND HEALTH CENTER AS "ARSENIO H. LACSON PUBLIC LIBRARY AND HEALTH CENTER".

WHEREAS, the building presently housing the Sta. Ana Public Library and Health Center was constructed during the incumbency and under the initiative of the late Mayor Arsenio H. Lacson;

WHEREAS, the late Mayor Arsenio H. Lacson had earned the singular distinction as "the best Mayor Manila ever had";

WHEREAS, it was during the tenure of this man, who was highly respected by his friends and admirers as well as by his enemies, that the residents of the City of Manila witnessed marked improvements in the city administration and the rapid rehabilitation and development of this city;

WHEREAS, as a lasting tribute to the man who had done the best he could offer to this city, it is but proper and fitting that his name be perpetuated by naming some permanent public improvements after him: Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The building presently housing the Sta. Ana public library and health center is hereby named "Arsenio H. Lacson Public Library and Health Center".


SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


