AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF DORMITORIES AND BOARDING HOUSES IN THE CITY OF MANIIA, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

- SECTION 1. Pormitery and beerding house defined .- . Any dermitory or boarding house within the mesning of this Ordinance shall be held to include any house or building or portion thereof in which six or more persons may be regularly accepted as bearders for compensation by the day, week or month.
- SEC. 2. Permits. Licenses -- It shall be unlawful for any person, entity or corporation to own, keep, maintain or conduct any boarding house or dermitery without first obtaining a permit from the Mayor and a license therefor duly approved by the proper city sutherities. The permit and license abovementioned shall specify the number of persons permitted to dwell or board in every boarding house or dormitory and shall always be displayed in a conspicuous place therein and no person shall maintain or conduct any dormitory or bearding house except in accordance with the terms and conditions of the license issued therefor,
- SEC. 3. Classes of dormitories and bearding houses .- For the purpose of this Ordinance, dermitories and boarding houses shall be classified as follows:
 - CLASS A: Dormitories and boarding houses having accommodations for 50 boarders or more;
 - CLASS B: Dormitories and bearding houses having accommodetions for 30 boarders or more but less then 50;
 - CLASS C: Dormiteries and boarding houses having accommedations for 20 boarders or more but less
 - CLASS D: Dermiteries and bearding houses having accommodations for more than five (5) but less than 20 boarders.
- SEC. 4. License fees for dermiteries and boarding houses .-There shall be paid for every license granted for dormitory and boarding house an annual license fee as follows:

- SEC. 5. Contents of Application .- Every person desiring to secure permit and license to own, keep, conduct or maintain any dormitory or boarding house shall, in his application, make a detailed statement of the following:
 - s. The kind of construction of the building;
 - The size of each room for guests or boarders;

Sanitary facilities; C.

- The condition of light and ventilation;
- e. The greatest number of persons that can be accommodated at any one time;
- f. Size of dining room;

g. Size of kitchen; and h. Number of employees.

SEC. 6. Dormitery and boarding house registers, premises and facilities open to inspection. No owner, manager, keeper or duly authorized representative of a dormitery or boarding house shall entertain or accept any guest, customer, or bearder therein, or let any room or other quarter to any person or persons before such person or persons have accomplished and signed the following form in the presence of and certified by such owner, manager, keeper or duly authorized representative.

All guests, boarders or customers in such dermitory or boarding house shall be required to fill out and sign the foregoing form. Information stated in the said form as required by this Ordinance should be true and correct. Such registration forms or records shall be kept and bound together by such owner, manager, keeper, or duly authorized representative. Such registration forms or records, and the premises and facilities of dermitories and boarding houses shall be open for inspection by the Mayor and/or the Chief of Police, or their duly authorized representatives.

- SEC. 7. Type of buildings.— s. Any 3-stery building erected for dermitery or bearding house for the accommodation of ever 100 persons or any building or section of building exceeding 3-stery to be used for said purposes, shall be of reinforced concrete structural framing or of steel structural framing covered with concrete. IRO-VIDED, HOWEVER, That existing 3-stery buildings presently being utilized as bearding houses or dermiteries shall be exempted from the requirements under this Section: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That if more than 50% of such buildings are altered the requirements herein provided shall be complied with.
- b. Bailding accommodating less than 100 persons shall not exceed 3-story in height or 12 meters if of non-fireproof structures but in no case lower in quality than that of a frame structure.
- SEC. 8. Exit requirements.— a. Passageways shall be properly lighted at each flight of stairs, at the intersection of corridors, and at the point of egress to fire escapes. A red light shall be kept during the night.
- b. Every boarding house or dormitery shall, whenever practicable, be provided with fire escapes, Fire escapes should be placed preferrably at street front of the building, far from the stairs and accessible from any point in any floor by means of a clear, unobstructed passageway of at least 1.00 m. wide. This width shall be maintained also on the passageway from the bottom of the fire escape to the street.
- SEC. 9. Alarm System. The premises of class A, B, and C bearding houses shall be provided with proper emergency alarm bell, sending stations or gengs which shall be conveniently located for easy access.
- SEC. 10. First Aid Fire Protection. The premises shall be provided with proper fire fighting facilities such as hese cabinets and fire extinguishers.
- SEC. 11. Storage of flammable liquids and combustible materials.—
 No storage of flammable liquids or combustible materials shall be
 placed on the passageways, fire escapes, stairs, and exits, or any
 part of the premises without permit from the Fire Department.
- SEC. 12. Lighting and electrical facilities. 3 a. All rooms, passageways, stairways and other parts of the premises shall be preparly and adequately lighted by natural or artificial means or by both in consonance with standards of illumination practices.

- b. Good lighting shall be provided in all rooms and premises and shall include illumination adequate in amount for such premises and rooms used for reading and study purposes shall have at least an illumination level of 50-foot candles.
- c. For Class A dormitories and boarding houses, the electrical Lighting facilities for passageways, stairways, and fire exits shall be connected on the supply side of the main service equipment of the building.
- d. All lighting equipments, devices and fixtures shall be regularly maintained and kept clean and in good working condition.
- e. The electrical installation and equipment shall be subject to the provision of the National Electrical Code and subject to inspection.
- SEC. 13. Study Room. A study room shall be provided every dormitory or boarding house with adequate lighting and ventilation.
- SEC. 14. Ventilation, size of rooms, bed spacing.— a. All buildings erected or altered for use as dormitory or boarding house shall have their rooms of such size that adequate air space shall be provided for each occupant. The minimum height of bedrooms shall be three meters, unless air—conditioned where it shall not be less than two-and-a-half meters, the minimum width, two meters, and the minimum length, three meters.
- b. All bedrooms shall have a window area of at least ten percent of the floor area unless sir-conditioned.
- c. Beds shall be so spaced so that the distance between two beds shall be at least sixty centimeters.
- SEC. 15. Evidence of evercrowding. Any dermitery or boarding house which does not follow the spacing for beds as herein prescribed shall be deemed overcrowded.
- SEC. 16. Senitary facilities: plumbing fixtures. Every dormitory or boarding house shall have at least one shower-head, one floor drain, one water closet and one laystory for every ten bearders.
- bearding houses prohibited.— It shall be unlawful for any person, entity or corporation to own, keep, maintain or conduct any dermitory or bearding house for mixed (male and female) bearders in the same building.
- SEC. 18. <u>Kitchen and Dining room requirements.</u>— a. Every dormitory or boarding house shall have a kitchen, with adequate natural or artificial lighting system or both which furnishes at least ten-foot candles on all working surfaces measured by a suitable light meter or photometer.
- b. The walls of the kitchen shall be comented up to the height of 1.25 meters from the floor.
- c. Kitchen shall be well ventilated by natural or artificial means or both. Steve hoods, chimney and exhaust ventilation system or adequate fans shall be provided when necessary.
- d. Kitchen and dining rooms shall be effectively acreemed against ies (8 to 12 mesh per linear inch) and provided with self-closing

- e. The minimum floor area of a kitchen shall be six square meters with minimum width of two meters for dormitories or boarding houses with less than 20 boarders; while those of more than 20 boarders shall have a kitchen with a minimum floor area of 12 square meters with a minimum width of three meters.
- f. Every boarding house or dormitory shall have a separate dining room with adequate ventilation and lighting system which furnishes at least ten-foot candles.
- SEC. 19. Premises to be kept clean and sanitary. The floors, wells, ceilings, windows, tables, chairs, beds, plumbing fixtures, kitchen, stairways, passageways, yard, driveways and alleys contiguous with the premises shall be kept clean, sanitary and free from rubbish, refuse, dust, dirt, useless or offensive materials, flies, rodents and other vermins.
- SEC. 20. Garbage receptacles. Suitable fly-proof and watertight garbage receptacles made of metal with metal tight fitting covers shall be provided. Every garbage and other waste materials shall be removed from the premises daily and shall not be allowed to become a nuisance. Immediately upon emptying such receptacles, same shall be properly cleaned.
- SEC. 21. Duty of owner, manager or keeper or duly authorized representatives of dermiteries and bearding houses.— It shall be the duty of the owner, manager or keeper or duly authorized representatives of dermiteries, bearding houses, and the like, to see that the previsions of this Ordinance are properly observed and that proper cleanliness is maintained at all times in the premises.
- SEC. 22. Health certificates required. Cooks, foodbandlers, and helpers who handle food for the boarders and other persons in dermiteries and boarding houses are hereby required to secure health certificates before being allowed to work and must possess up-to-date health certificates at all times.
- SEC. 23. Penalty.— In case of violation of any of the previsions of this Ordinancs, the license and permit to operate the dermitory or boarding house shall, after due hearing, be revoked by the Mayor, forfeiting to the City all sums paid therefor, and any person responsible for any such violation shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than fifty peace nor more than two hundred peace or imprisonment for not more than six months or by such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
- SEC. 24. Repealing clause, All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.
- SEC. 25. Effectivity This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
