

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PERSONS ENGAGED AS PAWNSHOP APPRAISER TO PAY AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE THEREFOR, UNDER CERTAIN CONDITION; AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. No person shall be employed as pawnshop appraiser unless he shall have paid to the City Treasurer the amount of fifty pesos (P50.00) annually, which amount may be paid in full or in two semi-annual installments, on or before the 25th day of January and July of each year: PROVIDED, That failure to pay the license fee within the prescribed time shall subject the licensee to a surcharge of twenty (20%) per centum of the amount due.

SEC. 2. No person shall be issued a license as pawnshop appraiser who had been previously convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude: PROVIDED, That the business address of such licensed appraiser shall also be the business address of the pawnshop wherein he is employed, and that for any change thereof, after due notice to the City Treasurer, a fee of P5.00 shall be imposed.


SEC. 3. Any person who shall engage in the profession mentioned in the preceding section without first securing the license therefor shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than fifty pesos (P50.00) nor more than one hundred pesos (P100.00) or by imprisonment for not less than five (5) days nor more than thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.


SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


