

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE EMPLOYMENT OF ANY OFFICER OR MEMBER OF THE MANILA POLICE DEPARTMENT AS BOUNCER, GUARD, FLOOR MANAGER OR IN ANY OTHER CAPACITY IN ANY NIGHTCLUB, COCKTAIL LOUNGE, RESTAURANT, BAR AND THE LIKE; AND PENALIZING VIOLATION THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The employment of any officer or member of the Manila Police Department as bouncer, guard, floor manager or in any other capacity in any nightclub, cocktail lounge, restaurant, bar and the like is hereby prohibited. This provision shall apply to any officer or member of the Manila Police Department who receives any kind of consideration, monetary or otherwise, from any of said establishments.


SEC. 2. Any person violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than ₱200.00 or imprisonment of not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court. In case of violation by a corporation or entity, the President, Manager and/or person in charge shall be liable therefor. Officers or members of the Manila Police Department are likewise liable under the foregoing provision without prejudice to their criminal or administrative prosecution under existing laws, rules and regulations.


SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


