

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS OF MOVIE HOUSES, THEATERS AND OTHER SIMILAR ESTABLISHMENTS TO PLAY THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL ANTHEM BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW AND/OR SCREENING TIME AND DURING THE INTERMISSION BEFORE THE LAST FULL SHOW OF THE DAY; AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Owners of movie houses, theaters and other similar establishments are hereby required to play the Philippine National Anthem before the start of the show and/or screening time and during the intermission before the last full show of the day.

SEC. 2. Any person violating the provision of this ordinance shall be penalized, upon conviction, by a fine of not more than P200.00 or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.


In case of corporation or partnership violating this ordinance the penalty provided for in paragraph one of this Section shall be imposed on the President, Manager or to the Officer having control of the establishments mentioned in Section one hereof.


SEC. 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
