

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P21,040.85, TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AS ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION TO COVER THE REFUND OF MEAT INSPECTION FEES COLLECTED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2991 WHICH WAS DECLARED ILLEGAL BY THE SUPREME COURT.

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The amount of P21,040.85, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds (from the surplus realized by the city as of June 30, 1963) existing in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated to be made available to cover the refund of meat inspection fees collected under Ordinance No. 2991 which was declared illegal by the Supreme Court, itemized as follows:




SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila at its regular session today, December 27, 1963.


