CRDINANCE NO. . AN ORDINANCE RENAMING MILITAR STREET IN MALATE "DR. JOAQUIN QUINTOS SPREET." WHIGHEAS, service to the people as would be deserving of public honors has very often been equated with the holding of some high positions in the government; WHEREAS, the career of the late Dr. Josquin Quintos, as an eminent and highly esteemed specialist in children's diseases, "is a fitting example," as pointed out in the editorial of the TRIBUNE's issue of August 10, 1927, "of a great service that men in private life can render to the people." The late Dr. Joaquin Quintos was a partner of the firm Quintos and Ascona and was visiting physician of San Juan de Dios Hospital for many years where he maintained an exclusive ward for the treatment of children's diseases. He also held the post of professor in the college of medicine and surgery in the University of Sto. Tomas and until his death was one of the directing minds of the "Ia Proteccion de la Infancia," a benevolent society devoted to the welfare of infants; WHEREAS, no less than the late President Manuel L. Quezon, paying tribute to the memory of Dr. Joaquin Quintos, said: "With his death the country lost one of its most illustrious sons, a true patriot, a great physician, a model husband and a father, a sincere and loyal friend. He was my children's physician and I owe him eternal gratitude." WHEREAS, a man like the late Dr. Joaquin Quintos, who served his country truly and well, deserves the eternal gratitude of his people and such gratitude may be properly expressed by renaming some public street in the City of Manila after him: Now, there-Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that: SECTION 1. Militar Street in Malate is hereby renamed "Dr. Joaquin Quintos Street." HERMINIO A. ASTORGA Vice-Mayor and Presiding Officer, Municipal Board
