OKDINE NO. 1501-11239 AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE ISLAND LOCATED ON HERRAN SPREET FRONT-ING THE STA. ANA CHURCH, DISPRICT OF STA. ANA, "LIWA SANG FELIPE CALDERON. "

WHEREAS, the island located on Herran Street fronting Sta. Ana Church, District of Sta. Ana, does not bear any name;

WHEREAS, the Historical Markers Committee, in recognition of the contribution of Don Felipe Calderon to Philippine history, has placed a historical marker in his honor at the island above-mentioned:

WHEREAS, the naming of the said island after Don Felipe Calderon will appropriately do honor to the great man who authored the Malokos Constitution and served the cause of freedom for the Filipinos courageously and well: Now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The island located on Herran Street front-ing the Sta. Ana Church, District of Sta. Ana, is hereby named "Liwasang Felipe Calderon."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

Originally enacted by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila on July 21, 1965; vetoed by His Honor, the Mayor on August 13, 1965 and repassed with modification by said Body at its regular session today, September 22, 1965.
