**REORGANIZATION OF THE MANILA DISASTER RISK
REDUCTION & MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (MDRRMC)**

WHEREAS, under *Section 455 paragraph (b)(2) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 7160*, otherwise known as the *Local Government Code of 1991*, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Manila has the power to enforce all laws and ordinances relative to the governance of the city;

WHEREAS, pursuant to *Section 2 (e) of RA No. 10121*, otherwise known as "*Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010*" it is the policy of the State to develop, promote, and implement a comprehensive National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) that aims to strengthen the capacity of the local government units (LGUs) together with partner stakeholders to build disaster resilient communities and to institutionalize arrangements and measures for reducing disaster risk, including projected climate risk and enhancing disaster preparedness and response at all levels;

WHEREAS, based on *Section 6 (f) of RA No. 10121*, the National Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (NDRRMC) is mandated to develop appropriate risk transfer mechanism that shall guarantee social and economic protection and increase resilience in the face of disaster;

WHEREAS, Manila City wishes to align itself to the National Government's policy to adopt a disaster risk reduction and management approach that is holistic, comprehensive, integrated, proactive, and participative especially at the local community level and in times of disaster/calamities and any unforeseen events;

WHEREAS, the city signed last December 2020, a 3-year Memorandum of Agreement with the National Resilience Council, Carlos P. Romulo Foundation for Peace and Development, Inc., International Container Terminal Services Inc. Foundation, and the Bank of the Philippine Islands Foundation to pursue the implementation of the Resilient Local Government Unit Program;

THEREFORE, I, **MARIA SHEILAH "HONEY" H. LACUNA-PANGAN, MD, FPDS**, Mayor of the City of Manila, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the 1987 Philippine Constitution, the Local Government Code of 1991, and existing laws, hereby order the reorganization of the Expanded Manila Disaster Risk Reduction Council (MDRRMC) as follows:

Section 1. Composition. To effectively pursue the objectives of this executive order, there is a need for the city to expand the membership and redefine the functions of the existing Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council. Thus, MDRRMC shall include representatives from key stakeholders of the Resilient Local Government Unit Program and shall be composed of the following:

- a. Designation of the Focal Person for the Resilient Local Government Unit Program. – The Executive Director shall be the overall officer-in-charge of the Resilient Local Government Unit Program and shall designate the Focal Person for the said Program.
- b. Secretariat. – The Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) shall serve as the Secretariat of the MDRRMC.

Section 2. Responsibilities and Functions. Aside from the applicable functions under *Section 6 of RA No. 10121*, MDRRMC shall also be charged with the following functions and responsibilities:


1. Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
2. Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
3. Recommend the implementation of forced or pre-emptive evacuation of local residents in times of calamities, if necessary;
4. Convene once every three (3) months or as may be necessary;
5. Facilitate the implementation of the projects under the Resilient LGU Program;
6. Ensure the active collaboration and coordination with National Resilience Council, Carlos P. Romulo Foundation for Peace and Development, Inc., International Container Terminal Services Inc. Foundation, and the Bank of the Philippine Islands Foundation and other stakeholders in the formulation, implementation and monitoring of activities and projects in line with the Resilient LGU Program;
7. Provide logistical and operational support to the Resilient LGU Program planning, implementation and evaluation;
8. Facilitate legislative action to establish LGU-based structures and protocols that will ensure the resilience of the city's local government systems;
9. Ensure active support of the entire MDRRMC in meetings and learning sessions of the Resilient LGU program.

Section 5. All prior inconsistent orders, issuances, or directives are considered repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 6. This Order consists of only three (3) pages and shall take effect immediately upon issuance.

Section 7. A copy of this Executive Order shall be furnished the Office of the President, Malacañang Palace, pursuant to paragraph (b)(xii), Section 455 of the Local Government Code of 1991.
