

ORDINANCE NO. 8029

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THAT CENTER ISLAND AT PRESIDENT QUIRINO AVENUE LOCATED ALONG THE ROUTE GOING TO BAGONG BARANGAY ZAMORA, PANDACAN, MANILA AS "PLAZOLETA ARGENTINA".

Be it Ordained by the City Council of Manila, THAT:

SECTION 1. That center island at President Quirino Avenue located along the route going to Bagong Barangay Zamora, Pandacan, Manila is hereby named "Plazoleta Argentina".

SEC. 2. The City Engineer's Office is hereby directed to install the corresponding marker at a conspicuous place thereat.




