WHEREAS, the members of the national team displayed brilliance and excellence in the field of electronic sports where video gamers compete against each other in a virtual environment;

WHEREAS, the national team not only dominated Vietnam but Singapore as well, despite the seemingly technological advantage of the latter over the Philippines;


WHEREAS, the success of the Sibol national team is another proof of the world-class talent, skill and passion of the Filipino youth;
