WHEREAS, On June 24 2023, the civil and military parade that served as the highlight of the celebration of the 452nd Founding Anniversary of the City of Manila drew about seven thousand (7,000) residents of Manila to Moriones Street in Tondo;

WHEREAS, the city government planned the Civil and Military Parade to highlight the cultural diversity of Magnificent Manila. Additionally, it was meant to convey to the city's various sectors of the local government's gratitude and support;

WHEREAS, the parade showcased the culture and creativity of the locals by including vibrant performances by students and colorful floats from each of the city's six districts, departments, cooperatives, non-government organizations and people's organization, private sectors, schools, government agencies such as the Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (DRRMO), Manila Police District (MPD), Bureau of Fire Protection-Manila Fire District (BFP-MFD), Bureau of Jail Management and Penology-Manila City Jail (BJMP-MCJ), Joint Task Force National Capital Region-Armed Forces of the Philippines (NCR-AFP) Contingent, Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and Manila Field Office (MFO);


WHEREAS, Rajah Sulayman, one of the well-known leaders of Manila in the past, was honored by the Muslim community of Manila, which also sent representatives and a float to show their culture and appreciation;

WHEREAS, the different floats of the six legislative districts of the city were accompanied by their respective Congressmen and Councilors. District 1 performed the Lakbayaw festival dances, followed by District 2 for the Caracol festival, District 3 for the Chinatown festival, District 4 for the Bulaklakan festival, District 5 for the Tatarin festival, and District 6 for the Buling-buling festival;

WHEREAS, the successful observation of the Manila City Civil and Military Parade is proof that the City Government of Manila, under the leadership of the first ever female Mayor, Honorable Maria Sheila "Honey" H.
